Remarks:

Mandandeupur municipality – 3, Nayagaun Kavrepalanchok is a district of Nepal among the 75 districts which was also affected and badly hit by the 2015 Nepal earthquakes. Not all buildings have collapsed but all are cracked and deemed unsafe to stay. Villagers received some funding from the government and have started rebuilding their houses.

The school here has also been renovated but unfortunately not the toilets. Existing toilets are temporary and not suitable for use. Students and teachers no longer use them and opt to answer nature's call at some hidden spots or go back to their own homes a distance away. This affects the schooling environment and increases chances of falling sick due to hygiene issues. Human waste excreted in nature also pollutes the water source that villagers consume.

Project:

- **Build toilets with two cubicles, complete with septic tank and proper sewage system** to ensure waste is disposed in the right manner. Proper waste disposal can help prevent water-borne diseases amongst children and villagers. The toilets will be made of cement, sand, iron and bricks.
- **Outfit the classrooms with good quality furniture and flooring** so that the younger children can have a more conducive learning environment. Items required are round tables, carpets and floor mats to help keep the children warm during winter classes when the floor gets too cold.
